

Remote Kindy!


We are extremely excited to announce that Ubobo State School is 1 of 19 schools selected to be a Remote Kindergarten school starting Term 1, 2019. Kindergarten is available to children who have turned four on or before June 30, 2019. The kindergarten program will be delivered for 15 hours each week during the school terms by our teachers, with additional teacher aide support. This is an incredible opportunity for families in the Boyne Valley. We are fortunate to have two Remote Kindergarten schools in 2019, with Builyan State School also a facility. This enables families to send their child to the facility closest to their home.

Kindy enrolment forms will be arriving at school next week. We are really excited about this new opportunity.
